2. Share Your Experience

Include your years in real estate, areas of focus, brokerage, and any awards.

"With 10+ years in the San Gabriel Valley, I've helped hundreds of clients from starter homes to multi-unit investments."

3. Emphasize Local Knowledge

Show your connection to the area you serve.

"Born and raised in Pasadena, I offer a hyper-local perspective on every deal."

4. Focus on Client Service

Describe your working style and how you help clients succeed. "I believe in clear communication and fiercely advocating for my clients' best interests."

5. Highlight Team Support

If part of a team, explain how that benefits clients.

"As leader of The Chou Team, I've built a group focused on seamless, full-service experiences."

6. Add a Personal Detail

Include something relatable about yourself.

"Outside of work, I enjoy coaching youth basketball and hiking with my family."

7. Close with a CTA

End with a clear reason to connect.

"Whether you're buying your first home or downsizing, I'm here to help you move forward with confidence."
